

This program is presented from a table rather than from the pulpit. We ask that you provide the following items:

☐ One table (banquet sized) with a white cloth or paper covering
☐ Two 10" or 12" white candles (dripless preferred)
☐ Candle Holders
☐ Matches
☐ Four clear plastic cups filled 1/3 full with grape juice
☐ Three whole matzahs to be used for the Matzah Tosh
(No small crackers)
☐ Matzah Tosh*
☐ 1 teaspoon of prepared or ground horseradish
(Do not use the creamy kind. Find one in the dairy section made by Kraft)
☐ Charoseth - mix together:
a. 1 cup apples, peeled and grated
b. 1/4 cup chopped nuts, preferably walnuts
c. 1 tablespoon honey
d. 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon
e. 4 tablespoons grape juice
*Allow the mixture to turn brown (should resemble
the clay or mortar that the Israelites made in Egypt)*
☐ 1/2 cup of salt water
☐ Parsley - 2-3 sprigs
☐ One brown egg, hard cooked, DO NOT PEEL (a white egg can be

boiled in coffee or tea to give brown appearance)

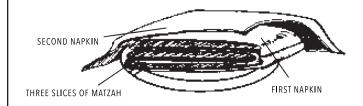
A place setting at one end of the table (for Elijah!)

(One luncheon sized plate and one cup)

☐ Two medium sized pillows, in pillowcases on chairs on either end

The Matzah Tosh*

Layer three pieces of Matzah (unleavened bread) between the folds of a dinner-sized white cloth or paper napkin. Place another dinner-sized napkin on top of the Matzahs.
